Vince McMahon comes out to open the show, and says that Raw is in need of a credible general manager. Somebody that knows what they're doing. Vince says he's found the new GM and he will introduce them next week on Raw! But until then, Vince is going to restore some order to the show, by announcing two huge matches tonight! The United States Championship will be on the line as Kofi Kingston defends against Mark Henry, and says he knows John Cena will want revenge for what happened last night at SummerSlam, but he'll have to earn it, there will be a fatal four way number one contenders match for the WWE Championship. John Cena vs MVP vs Jack Swagger vs Carlito. He says Randy Orton will have to answer for what he did, orchestrating the interference of someone who's not even an employee of the WWE

Legacy interrupts. Orton says Legacy is always one step ahead of the competition because they're wrestling royalty. The WWE Champion says Cena took his eye off the ball last night, and that Cena doesn't deserve another chance at the title and says to put Rhodes or DiBiase in the match instead. Vince says they're already booked tonight. Because he had two wrestlers who wanted to join the tag ranks come up to him and ask for a shot. So Rhodes and DiBiase will take on Chris Masters and Santino Marella! Vince ends the segment by saying Orton has tonight off, but next week he is in the main event against Shawn Michaels!

Match 1| Evan Bourne vs Chavo Guerrerro *quick match, highlighting the athleticism of both men. Chavo looks for a frog splash, but BOURNE GETS THE KNEES UP! Bourne climbs to the top rope, SHOOTING STAR PRESS! Bourne hooks the leg! 1...2...3!! Winner: Evan Bourne @ 4:36*

DX are backstage sitting in massage chairs, as the camera angle is on their faces through the chair. Triple H says "wow Shawn if I knew getting the pin got me a chance to get my hands on Orton I would've pinned Cody earlier." HBK laughs and says "ya know Hunter, It may not be for the title, but a sweet chin music will still feel just as good. I have a feeling we're not done with those silver spoon SOBs. So before they even go on the attack we want to put the challenge out there. Breaking Point, Cody and Ted, we go to war one more time. And we've got two words for ya!"

Match 2| Beth Phoenix vs Alicia Fox

Mickie James is on commentary, putting over the women's Title match that Beth earned, saying she wants to scout the opposition. Beth dominates early and throughout. Going through a couple suplexes and side slams before lifting Fox up and dropping her with the Glam Slam! Winner: **Beth Phoenix** @2:48

The Miz is shown backstage, standing by Kristal Marshall. Kristal asks Miz if he's looking forward to his opportunity to take on a champion tonight, as he goes one on one with The Big Show. Miz scoffs

The Miz: Am I excited Kristal? Do I look excited? There's a United States championship match up next, I'd be excited if I was part of that. There's a number one contender match for the WWE title tonight. THAT would get me going. What is a match against one half of the tag champs going to do? I don't even have a tag team partner. So I have to go against that giant FREAK Big Show, who didn't even win the title!! He was Edge's replacement. People forget that like it was ten years ago or something. And what do I gain from this match? Nothing! This company is wasting one of their best assets, their only A-List star. They better recognize it before it's too late. Because I'm the Miz... AND IM AWESOME!!

Match 3| Kofi Kingston vs Mark Henry

*This match was a back and forth affair, with Henry looking to use his strength to overpower Kofi, but Kingston able to slip out of most attempts. Henry whipped Kingston into the corner, and Chase's after his opponent looking for a splash - but Kingston moves!! Kofi bounces off the opposite ropes as Henry staggers out and looks for a cross body - CAUGHT BY HENRY, WORLDS STRONGEST SLAM!! Henry makes the cover! 1..2..No!! Kofi gets his shoulder up, and Henry is on the attack. Henry pulls Kingston up by his hair before tossing him into the corner. Henry rams his shoulder into the gut of Kofi, once, twice, th-No! KOFI SUNSET FLIPS HENRY, SHOULDERS DOWN! 1..2..NO!! Henry kicks out, but as he rises to his feet, Kingston is already up, TROUBLE IN PARADISE!!! Hooks the leg! 1..2..3!! Kingston retains his title! Winner: **Kofi Kingston**@ 13:22*

John Cena backstage interview saying he got cheated last night, but the only thing royal about Legacy is the ass-whooping they're going to get. Cena adds that if he wins tonight he wants warm up matches against Rhodes and DiBiase before breaking point. "I don't even care what DiBiase it is. Brett, Ted Jr, Ted Sr, or Melanie!"

Match 4| The Miz vs The Big Show

*The bell rings and Miz immediately leaves the ring as Big Show stepped towards him. The referees pleading with Miz to re-enter the ring so the match can get started, otherwise he's going to have to count Miz out. Miz waves his arms and starts walking back up the ramp, but is stopped by Show!! Big Show clubs Miz on the back, grabbing him by the head and walking back towards the ring. Miz elbows free and grabs Show, looking to whip him into the steps - BUT SHOW DOESN'T BUDGE. Instead, Big Show pulls Miz the other way - launching him straight into the barricade!! The referee has started his count (at 4 now) since the men are actually fighting now on the outside. Show lifts Miz up onto his shoulders, looking to lawn dart Miz into the steel post - but Miz slips off, RUNNING SHOW INTO THE POST!! The referees count is at 7 when Miz realizes what's going on, Big Show is still on his feet staggering as Miz runs him into the post again!! Miz rolls in right as the referee counts to 9, followed by 10 with Show still at ringside!! Winner: **The Miz @ 1:10***

Jerry Lawler: The Miz just beat a champion in just over a minute!

Cody Rhodes and Ted DiBiase are seen walking backstage, they're match is next!

Legacy

We come back from commercial to Marella and Masters already in the ring, with Legacy making their way down, jawing with the crowd. Just 24 hours after a battle with D-Generation X at Summerslam last night, Cody Rhodes and Ted Dibiase Jr. appear to be very confident leading into their match with the new tag team.

Match 5 | Legacy vs Santino Marella and Chris Masters *This is a short, awkward match as Marella is trying to convince Masters that they can be a good team. But*

they miscue on each tag move they attempt. A double suplex was mistimed and Marella fell on his back while Masters held up Rhodes, which allowed DiBiase to save Cody after a kick to the stomach followed by a double DDT! Marella grabs DiBiase with a school boy! 1.. No! Cody breaks up the pin instantly and lifts Marella to his feet, looking for a back suplex - reversed, Santino with the bulldog!! DiBiase stands up, waiting for Marella to turn around but Chris Masters gets him in the Master lock!! Santino goes for a big forearm but DiBiase ducks- SANTINO HITS MASTERS! Masters rolls to the outside, as Ted Jr goes behind Santino, DREAM STREET! Cody slides in to give extra leverage on the pin attempt. 1..2..3! Winners:

MVP is shown walking to the ring, with the #1 Contenders match coming up next, and MVP riding the momentum of his victory last night at Summerslam, can he keep ballin? --- WAIT! JACK SWAGGER IS BEHIND HIM WITH STEEL CHAIN!! SWAGGER RUNS THROUGH MVP WITH A SHOT TO THE BACK OF THE HEAD!! Swagger continues the assault with Porter on the ground. Hitting him two more times before security can intervene. Road Agents check on MVP as Vince tells Swagger he's out of the main event, and to go home before he decides to arrest him.

Match 6| John Cena vs Carlito vs MVP?

Cena and Carlito start the match with MVP still being attended to by paramedics in the back. Cena is on the offensive, looking aggressive after being so close to the championship last night. Cena hits a shoulder block, bounces off the ropes and hits another shoulder block. Carlito gets back up, into a fisherman suplex from Cena!!

Cena gets up and looks to be going for the Attitude Adjustment! But gets distracted by Randy Orton walking down the aisle! Cena looks out at Orton and waves his arms hoping to goad the champ into the ring. But Cena took his eyes off his opponent too long! CARLITO WITH THE BACKCRACKER!! Carlito goes for the cover! 1..2..No!! Cena kicks out!! Carlito can't believe Cena kicked out, and gets the former champ in a chin lock, digging his knee into Cena's back. Carlito wrenches on the neck but knows he can't win this way so he picks Cena up and backs him into the corner, choking Cena. Referee Jack Doane steps in as he reaches the count of 5 but cena shoves Carlito back- INTO THE REFEREE! Cena lifts Carlito up - ATTITUDE ADJUSTMENT!! But there's no referee to make the cover! Cena gets up, INTO AN RKO!! Orton strikes immediately, with Doane starting to stir he slides back out. And as Orton is walking back up the ramp, DOWN COMES MVP! Holding his head and with his ribs taped up, MVP is on his way to the ring!! Commentary says there's no way he should be out here, MVP slides into the ring as Carlito is using the ropes to pull himself up. MVP kicks Carlito in the stomach,

AND HITS THE PLAYMAKER!! MVP for the win! 1..2..NO!! John Cena lunges onto MVP to break up the pin. MVPs face drops as he realizes he missed a great opportunity to put the match away. Cena and MVP are both to their feet at the same time but MVP hits a dropkick to the knee to knock Cena to one knee before hitting a running elbow knocking Cena down. MVP lifts up Cena, looking for the playmaker! CARLITO WITH THE BACKCRACKER ON PORTER!!! But Cena is still up, Carlito doesn't realize it!! CENA LIFTS CARLITO UP, ATTITUDE ADJUSTMENT!! CENA WITH THE PIN! 1...2...3!!!! Winner: **John Cena @ 15:09**

John Cena celebrates the victory, as he WILL get his rematch against Randy Orton at Breaking Point.

RKO!!!! RANDY ORTON SNUCK INTO THE RING AND ATTACKED HIS CHALLENGER!! Orton poses to the crowd as we fade out.

We open with a video package, showing the highlights from ECW's only match at Summerslam; Christian's 8 second pinfall victory over William Regal, followed by The Kings Court attacking the champion post match.

REGALITY

William Regal comes out with Jackson and Kozlov. He says everybody thought Kozlov and Jackson would fight each other after trying to one up one another every week for the last month. But that he knew better, and knew how dominant of a tag team they can be. And they'll be looking to make some noise against the Tag Champions very soon. But first- Christian. Regal calls out the ECW Champion, saying Christian didn't even face him like a man. Regal says Christian isn't a fighting champion like people say, and that he deserves a bloody rematch.

Christian comes out and says normally he would agree with Regal, but only for people that could last longer than one minute, and that Regal is probably used to being finished in a minute.

There's a pop from the crowd but The trio have had enough with that line - and start to put the boots to Christian. Christian is trying to fight them off but just like two nights ago, the sheer size and strength of Ezekiel Jackson and Vladimir Kozlov are too much to handle. The henchmen hold up Christian as Regal pulls out the brass knuckles!!

BUT CHRIS JERICHO AND THE BIG SHOW ARE RUNNING DOWN THE RAMP! Chris Jericho dropkicks William Regal, and Big Show takes down both behemoths with a double clothesline. Regal rolls out of the ring, but as Zeke is getting up, Jericho hits him with a running bulldog. And Vladimir gets a big boot for his troubles! They follow Regal out of the ring, hightailing it up the ramp to join their leader. Christian yells "who's not a fighting man now?"

We come back to a graphic, interim GM Tiffany announced that tonight, William Regal, Ezekiel Jackson and Kozlov will take on Christian and JeriShow in the main event! If Regal and the Kings Court win, he will become the #1 contender to the ECW title!

Match 1 | Paul Burchill vs The Hurricane

Paul Burchill is laughing as Hurricane enters the ring. Hurricane whips his cape and poses, but Burchill runs through him with a big boot!!! Burchill lifts up Hurricane, up onto his shoulders, powerslam!! Paul picks the superhero back up, before bieling him across the ring. Hurricane bounces off the canvas, rolling onto his knees. Burchill RUNS THROUGH HURRICANE WITH A HUGE BOOT!! Paul picks Helms up, BURNING HAMMER!! 1..2..3!! Winner: Paul Burchill @ 2:08

A graphic pops up of Sheamus and Goldust "Up next!" Matt Striker and Josh Matthews run down the past few weeks of ECW programming, with Sheamus and Goldust forming somewhat of a rivalry, with Sheamus getting the win over the veteran back on August 4th and July 28th. Striker tells us Goldust got hurt in that last match, but makes his return tonight and he wants to take it to the younger Sheamus.

We come back from break and Goldust is already in the ring, with Sheamus making his way down the ramp. Staring a hole through Goldust, no playing to the fans or psyching himself up. Straight business from the Irishman.

Match 2 | Sheamus vs Goldust

Sheamus was in control throughout the match. Goldusts only "offense" came when Sheamus had him ready for a belly to belly, and Goldust squeezed Sheamus' butt.

It stopped the move, but it did not stop the attack as Sheamus ran through Goldust with a brogue kick!! Before lifting him up and dropping him with the Celtic Cross!! 1..2..3! Winner: Sheamus @ 3:14

We cut to the General Managers office backstage. With the announcement that there will only be 6 more weeks of ECW, Tiffany let's everyone know they are all on watch as every superstar will be drafted to either Raw or SmackDown. And that last episode of ECW will be a special 2 hour event!

Match 3| Shelton Benjamin vs Local Talent

This is a showcase match for Shelton Benjamin. He gets in all his offense, stopping the local competitor from gaining momentum at every turn. The jobber reverses an Irish whip into the corner, but as he looks for a clothesline in the corner he catches turnbuckle as Benjamin slips out, hits the ropes and hits the splash in the corner! Then grabs his opponent, t-bone suplex!!! Shelton helps the poor guy up and drops him with the paydirt!! He covers! 1..2..3!! Winner: Shelton Benjamin @ 4:37

Zack Ryder comes out, and says good riddance to ECW. He says they never should have brought it back, and the only reason it was even successful this long is because Ryder is a part of the show. Ryder says that he can't wait to go to a real brand like raw or SmackDown. Stating ECW has always been third in a two horse race. But that he will be issuing an open challenge at the final ECW event to any former ecw alumni. To prove that ECW has always been second rate.

Tommy Dreamer interrupts Ryder, as the only ECW alumni active right now. Dreamer makes his way to the ring with a steel chair - and HE LEVELS RYDER WITH IT!! Dreamer plays to the fans as Ryder rolls out of the ring.

Match 4| Christian, Chris Jericho and Big Show vs Regal, Jackson and Kozlov

*This match breaks into chaos almost immediately, as Kozlov and Jackson keep goading Jericho and Big Show. Finally after Kozlov illegally enters the ring to make sure Christian can't make the tag, the tag champions make their way into the ring and it's on! Show and Kozlov are fighting on the outside, as Jericho and Christian work together to take down Ezekiel. Jericho cross bodies Jackson and both go over the top rope! As the referee checks on Jackson and Jericho, Regal pulls out the brass knuckles, **POWER OF THE PUNCH!!** Regal tosses the knuckles away, and makes the cover! 1..2..3!! Winners: The King's Court @ 8:55*

The Kings Court wins! Regal gets a pin over the champion! Matt Striker tells us that Regal is heading to Breaking Point to face Christian for the ECW Championship! The show closes with Regal and his henchmen standing tall in the ring.

Then he says someone stuck his nose where it doesn't belong, he says this championship comes with a target on his back. But I'm not backing down from anybody. Dead or alive. Undertaker, face me like a man! The lights go out! GONG!! The lights come back on with Punk spinning around in the ring looking for Taker, but there's nobody there. The mind games start with CM Punk from the Deadman. Punk leaves the ring looking for answers

Dolph Ziggler is in Teddy Long's office, and says that he should be the new intercontinental champion since he was the one to injure Rey. Long says "you don't get rewarded for hurting your opponent playa you get rewarded for BEATING your opponent. But you'll have a chance to win the title at Breaking Point. Because we're going to have an 8 man tournament with the finals taking place at the PPV to crown the new champion. And you better get ready Dolph.. cause your match is up next!

Kane's fire pyro goes off

As Kane walks to the ring JR tells everyone SmackDown is short handed tonight as THREE different SmackDown superstars were injured this past Sunday at

Summerslam. Jeff Hardy got hurt falling from the ladder and will be out indefinitely. And the other two injuries came at the hands of these two men. The Great Khali hurt his knee in a match with Kane and while Rey Mysterio successfully defended his Intercontinental title against Dolph Ziggler, afterwards the medical staff let him know he can't wrestle for at least two months. Meaning he had to relinquish the title, which is what led to this tournament being created by our general manager.

The two men who injured their opponents Sunday night square off, with Ziggler spending most of the commercial break trying to avoid Kane. And its working until Kane chases him all the way around the ring on the outside, Dolph tries for a baseball slide as Kane climbs in but Dolph misses! Kane pulls him out by his legs and he hits the floor with hard impact! Kane lifts Dolph up, over his head in a military press! Before tossing him through the middle rope back into the ring.

Kane rolls in to the ring, but is met by an elbow drop from Ziggler. Dolph is stomping on Kane but The Big Red Machine gets up anyways, and stops him in his tracjs with a huge uppercut! Dolph hits the mat but bounces right back up, Kane looks for the big boot, Ziggler ducks AND KANES FOOT IS STUCK ON THE TOP ROPE - ZIG ZAG!! Hooks the leg! 1..2..No!! The crowd pops for the kickout of the finisher. Ziggler pulls at his hair. Kane uses the ropes to pull himself up, FAMOUSER!! Dolph doesn't let up as Kane was rising to his feet he pulls out another signature move, BUT KANE ROLLS OUT OF THE RING!! Dolph looks mad he can't make the cover, and he knows he's not rolling kane back in the ring easily. He starts to climb up the turnbuckle, Kane is on his feet, Dolph leaps off for a cross body - CAUGHT BY KANE, RAN INTO THE STEEL POST!! Kane drops Ziggler! Kane picks up his opponent and rolls him into the ring, following him in. Kane pulls at the glove and taunts to the crowd. Dolph is rising to his feet, Kane grabs the throat! Lifts him up - NO! DOLPH COUNTERS INTO A LEAPING DDT!! Dolph wastes no time making the pin! 1..2..3!! Winner: Dolph Ziggler @ 13:18

Match 2 | Mike Knox vs R-Truth *As Knox is climbing into the ring, Truth hits the scissors kick! Pinfall! 1..2..3! Truth picks up the fast victory! Winner: R-Truth @ 0:05*

R-Truth celebrates and rolls out of the ring quickly, winning the match instantly. Truth moves on in the tournament! Knox is in the ring seething.

We cut to the back where Matt Hardy is standing by with Josh Matthews

Josh Matthews: "Ladies and Gentlemen, I'm joined by Matt Hardy, who asked for this time tonight. Matt, why did you request this interview?"

Matt Hardy: "Josh, I asked for this time because it was the only way I was getting on the show tonight. I was overlooked for the intercontinental title tournament for some reason even though guys like Mike Knox who didn't even last 10 seconds, and past their prime veterans like Finlay got chances. CM Punk took out my brother on Sunday night, and I can't even get a shot at him because The Undertaker decided he wants to work again.

So I asked for this time tonight to remind SmackDown I'm one of the best they've got. And they've made a huge mistake overlooking me. Oh, and Punk... I will get my revenge for Jeff."

Matt tosses the mic back to Josh Matthews before walking off, looking energized and angry.

Commentary lets us know this match is part of the IC title tournament.

Match 3 | Charlie Haas vs John Morrison

Haas wins the early tie up and looks to wear down the legs of Morrison early, limiting his athleticism.

Haas knocks John down and looks for a submission but gets pushed away, Morrison nips up! Dropsault! Both men are back on their feet instantly, and Morrison is on the attack, spinning wheel kick!! Haas clutches at his jaw as he gets to his feet a little slower this time. Morrison grabs him, STO backbreaker!! Followed by a Russian leg sweep! Morrison looking for the early win! 1..2. No!

Haas kicks out, and as Morrison brings him to his feet, Haas reverses, back body drop! Morrison bounces up quickly but is caught by Haas- NORTHERN LIGHTS SUPLEX! And now Morrison is the one taking his time getting to his feet! And when he does Haas is on top of him, arm drag - No! Morrison flipped out of it and landed on his feet! Heel kick connects! Haas is down, standing shooting star press! Hooks the leg! 1..2-No! Haas gets a shoulder up! Morrison pulls Haas into position near the corner, looking for the starship pain- BUT HAAS IS UP AND SHOVES HIM OVER THE ROPE TO THE FLOOR!! Mike Chioda goes to check on Morrison, and while he's on the outside nobody notices Charlie Haas taking off the turnbuckle padding! Haas rolls to ringside, helping Morrison to his feet, only to whip him into the barricade! Morrison yells in agony as his back smacks across the barrier. Haas rolls him back into the ring and follows inside. He helps Morrison to his feet, walking him over to the corner looking to smash his head into the exposed turnbuckle! But Morrison hits Haas in the ribs to stop him in his tracks. Haas responds with a big uppercut! Morrison slumps into the corner, Haas charges at him, clothesline, NO! Morrison rolled out of the way and HAAS RUNS CHEST FIRST INTO THE EXPOSED TURNBUCKLE!! Morrison grabs Haas, twists him around - MOONLIGHT DRIVE!! Hooks the leg! 1..2..3!! Winner: John Morrison @ 12:47

Jim Ross: John Morrison moves on in the tournament! He will face the winner of Finlay and Jimmy Wang Yang next week on SmackDown. And we've just got word of a huge main event tonight, it's going to be CM Punk taking on Chris Jericho!

We come back from commercial with a graphic showing three matches now confirmed for next week. We have a tag team turmoil match to determine the number one contenders. And as part of the IC title tournament, Finlay will take on John Morrison and Dolph Ziggler will take on R-Truth.

Then we cut to the back where Chris Jericho and Big Show are standing talking together. Big Show asks why they even had to get involved with Christian and William Regal's problems on ECW. Jericho says that him and Christian go way back, and knew Regal would use his numbers advantage to attack the ECW champion again, so he wanted to save him as a favor for Jericho's former tag team partner Edge. Jericho thanks Big Show for his help, noting he didn't have to help him.

Just then CM Punk enters, insulting Jericho's integrity, saying he'll need all the help he can get tonight. Jericho says he doesn't need Big Show in his corner to beat a Punk, and points out that Punk may have his hands full with The Undertaker anyways. "See you out there, champ" says Jericho as he and Show walk away from the Straight Edge Superstar.

Match 5| Eve vs Natalya - Short, clunky match. Natalya is too much for Eve as she is able to overpower her easily. Natalya gets a few suplexes in before trapping Eve in the middle of the ring with a sharpshooter. Eve tries to reach for the bottom rope but taps out almost immediately. Winner: Natalya @ 2:29

Break the walls down

Chris Jericho comes out by himself, but carrying his championships, looking ready for a big non-title shot against the champion.

Cult of personality

And CM Punk struts his way to the ring, giving the fans disgusted looks. One fan holds out a beer and Punk smacks it out of his hand on his way down the ramp before stepping into the ring.

Match 6| CM Punk vs Chris Jericho

Jericho and Punk go to tie up, and Punk pokes Jericho in the eye! Punk ducks behind Y2J, and drops him with a Russian leg sweep!

Punk is in full control as we return, he has a half Boston crab locked in, digging his knee into the back of Jericho. Chris crawls his way towards the ropes and gets a hand on it! The referee starts his count, and Punk has to release before the 5. He helps Y2J to his feet, knee to the stomach, double underhook backbreaker!! Welcome to Chicago! Punk hooks the leg. 1..2.no! Jericho kicks out, but Punk doesn't waste any time picking his opponent up, whips him into the corner, runs in BUT JERICO GETS THE BOOTS UP.

Punk staggers back and Jericho hits a running forearm smash! Punk is in a bad spot, Jericho hits the middle ropes looking for the Lionsault - NOBODY HOME! Punk rolled out of the ring. CM Punk climbs up onto the apron, and jumps up, flying clothesline! The champion is rolling! Punk wrenches the arm of his opponent, picking apart Y2J, going after the legs early and now working on the arm. Y2J is trying to reach for the ropes with his foot, but is too far away!! Jericho uses his free hand to punch himself free, but as Punk let's go of the arm lock, he grabs Jericho and pulls him back into a headlock! Jericho is pushing to his feet, and lifts Punk up and drops him with a back suplex!!

Both men are up at the same time, and they start trading blows!! Right hand from Punk, right hand from Jericho, leg kick from Punk, Mongolian chop from Jericho, spinning back fist from Punk-No!! Jericho ducks, Punk does a 360, and Y2J hits a step up enziguiri!! The fans pop for the sequence of shots from both men.

Jericho picks Punk up and sends him out of the ring through the middle rope! Jericho follows him out, whipping the champion into the barricade! Jericho then lifts him up and drops him rib first onto the barrier! Punk clutches at his ribs, then makes a desperation lariat attempt, but Jericho ducks under, grabs Punk in a full Nelson, facebuster!!! Punk is down as the referees count reaches 5! But Jericho rolls him into the ring, looking to score the victory by pinfall or submission. He hooks Punks leg! 1..2.No! The champion gets his shoulder up, but is looking worse for wear after the brief onslaught from his opponent.

Jericho is up, and whips Punk into the corner. Running clothesline!! Punk staggers out as Jericho hits the ropes, one handed bulldog - PUNK PUSHES HIM AWAY! Punk pushes Jericho into the opposite corner, and follows with an immediate high knee!!! Followed up by a bulldog from the champion!!! Punk makes the cover! 1..2..No! Jericho kicks out, keeping the match going. Punk waits for Jericho to get

to his feet on his own, scoops him up, looking for the GTS! But Jericho throws an elbow, and another, and one more before he's able to slip off of Punks shoulders. And dropkicks the back of Punks head!!

Punk stumbles forward, leaning on the ropes, Jericho runs forward looking to clothesline him, but Punk ducks and back body drops Jericho over the top! JERICO LANDS ON HIS FEET!! Jericho lands on the apron, and catches Punk with a big forearm shot to the jaw. Jericho runs across the apron to the turnbuckle, climbing to the top rope. Diving cross body takes down Punk!!! But he rolls through!! PUNK LIFTS JERICO UP, PUTS HIM ON HIS SHOULDERS - GO TO SLEEP!!! The GTS connects!! But Jericho falls right near the bottom rope, and smartly rolls to the outside!! Punk looks irritated Jericho rolled out, but content to win by count out he tells referee Jack Doane to make the count. Jericho isn't even stirring and Doane begins the 10 count.

Jericho starts to show signs of life, pulling his head up, he reaches an arm up to the barricade to help himself up.

*Jericho now stands up, looking to get back on the ring, but here comes Punk!! He dives through the middle rope, SUICIDE DIVE - NO! CAUGHT BY JERICO INTO A CODEBREAKER!!!!!! WHAT A COUNTER!!! *HOLY SHIT**

JR says you can hear what the fans think of this match, an absolute classic going on here on SmackDown! Both men are down and out, Jericho still selling the GTS he took just moments ago. Referee Jack Doane conveniently checks on both competitors a couple times before starting his 10 count. Jericho is the first to get to his feet, and he helps Punk back into the ring as the count reaches 7. Jericho follows him in and makes the cover! 1..2. No!! Punk gets the shoulder up, the extended time outside giving him a chance to recoup. Jericho stands up, and grabs the legs of the champion, turning him over in THE WALLS OF JERICO!! He wrenches back, as the referee asks Punk if he wants to tap out! Punk reaches for the ropes but he's squarely in the middle of the ring!! Nowhere to go, as Jericho digs his knee into the back of Punk!! Punk raises his hand, screaming in agony, is he going to tap out?!

BIG BOOT TO THE FACE OF JERICO!! ITS KOZLOV AND JACKSON!!

Jackson lifts Jericho up to his feet, BOOK OF EZEKIEL!! And Kozlov follows up, hitting Jericho with the Iron Curtain!! William Regal is with them, and is heard saying "they'll be here next week for the tag team turmoil match dear boy. You shouldn't have started meddling where you don't belong." Regal then hits Jericho with the brass knuckles!! Big Show runs down the ramp, but The Kings Court scatter out of the ring, making their way up the ramp, a HUGE message sent to the tag team champions!

CM Punk is still in the ring, recovering from the battle with Y2J. As he goes to walk away - THE LIGHTS GO OUT!! When they come back on, THERE IS A CASKET OUTSIDE OF THE RING!! The casket is open, but empty. When a dark silhouette of the Undertakers face is shown on the titantron.

The Undertaker: "CM Punk, at Breaking Point - you will REST IN PEACE."

The lid of the casket then SLAMS SHUT all on its own! CM Punk jumps back a little bit, startled. He says off mic "it's just the wind"

"The message is loud and clear folks, at Breaking Point it's going to be CM Punk vs The Undertaker, in a casket match!!"
